

## APCP 50th Birthday £10,000 Grant Application Guidelines

This small grant provides financial support for up to two years duration, of <u>one</u>clearly formulated research proposal which aligns to the <u>APCP</u> <u>Objectives</u> and the top 10 <u>CSP</u> <u>Research Priorities</u>

An application detailing the proposed research is required (please use the official application form).

Awards will be made following review by a working group formed from the Professional Development Group and co-opted APCP members. Applications which encourage collaboration between centres are particularly welcome.

The principal investigator (PI) for this grant must be employed in a permanent position in a UK university, NHS trust, registered charity, or hospital and be an APCP member.

## An award of up to £10,000 will be made – submission deadline 29<sup>th</sup> February 2024.

Support may cover, a salary component, statistics support, consumables, meetings and travel, dissemination costs ie conference fees and open access journal. The application should not include any indirect costs such as administrative or other overheads imposed by the university or other institutions.

Timescales – list the start and finish dates as well as any specific milestones.

**Dissemination plans:** Please state how you plan to do this (publications, conferences, etc) and the likely costs involved. The APCP should be acknowledged. The APCP requires a Power Point

presentation or a poster to be displayed on the APCP Website and at the annual APCP Conference

**Please note:** Not all members of the team need to be APCP members. However, the **applicant** needs to be an APCP member, and you are expected to be the researcher on the projects. For example, a PhD student may apply for this grant to help support their project costs. The Principal Investigator would be your supervisor who would not be expected to be a member as they may be from another discipline. Please ensure, that as the applicant, you are explicit in your application about your role in the research. **The APCP** reserves the right to demand a refund of the award if it is deemed that the funds were used for purposes other than those stated in the application or if the project is not completed. The successful applicant will be announced by the **23<sup>rd</sup> April 2024**.
