

## Types of membership

There are two categories of membership:

- **Full Membership** - open to annually subscribing members of the CSP including associate, student and retired CSP members
- **Allied Membership** - for international physiotherapists who are not members of CSP and other professionals working in paediatrics

N.B. All UK based physiotherapists and support workers must be CSP members to be eligible for membership of APCP.

- **£20.00** - for students, retired members and therapy assistants
